In this method you need to call the phone number, it will ask you for the meeting ID, then you are joined to the meeting and can listen and talk with the rest of the participants!

You can always turn off your camera if you don’t want your picture shown. If you need help with the technology please let me know. I don’t post the links on social media since there are concerns of people jumping in and creating a disturbance. However, all are welcome. Drive-In Worship Guidelines

We all want to gather back together like before. However, we have an obligation to keep ourselves and our friends safe from this contagious virus! Please observe these guidelines for our “Drive-in Worship”. After we have some experience with this new way to worship, we will make revisions. Meanwhile please be patient and offer your suggestions!

- “drive-in worship” means we stay in our cars.
- Park on the North side of the church (side with the ramp)
- Parking Hosts will direct cars to park no closer than 10 ft. from each other.
- We ask that you do not leave your cars.
- The program with the words to the songs will be emailed and available on our webpage. Please download to your personal device or print off. There will not be any printed copies at the church.
- If you need to use a rest room there is one in the building, Please:
 - WEAR FACE MASKS WHEN OUTSIDE OF YOUR CAR!
 - MAINTAIN A MINIMUM OF 10 FT BETWEEN PEOPLE
 - ONLY ONE PERSON (or family) IN THE BUILDING AT A TIME
 - HAND SANITIZER IS LOCATED AT THE MAIN DOOR – PLEASE SANITIZE YOUR HANDS COMING INTO AND OUT OF THE CHURCH.
