

Kalamo In-Person Worship – Winter: 2020/2021

Health and Safety Guidelines rev 10/29/20

These are the precautions that we agree to practice:

Foundation

- These guidelines, as amended, will be agreed upon and observed for in-person worship services at our church building.
- If these guidelines are not observed, the Pastor will stop the worship service and leave the building.
- In-Person worship services will be every other Sunday to allow time for any contaminations to go dormant.
- Services will be planned to be no longer than 30 minutes to limit exposure, the format will closely follow the current online format.
- These guidelines are subject to change at any time based on current health trends.

Guidelines

- Hand sanitizer will be used upon entering the building. It is suggested that hand sanitizer be used when leaving the building.
- A face mask must be worn in the building at all times.
- Please, no touching, hand shaking, etc, maintain a safe distance of at least 6 feet at all times.
- No offering or sharing of refreshments will be served or allowed. Feel free to bring your own personal drink or snack, but please take any cups, etc home with you after the service.
- When entering, exiting, and moving about in the building strive to maintain at least 6 feet separation from other attendees.
- Seating will be such that families can sit together, but at least 6 feet from other attendees.
- People not living in the same house must ask permission before sitting next to someone else. Please be sensitive to others' safety concerns.
- The south door will be entrance only, the center double doors will be exit only.
- There will be no singing out-loud during songs, humming is suggested.
- There will be no church-provided handouts, hymnals, or Bibles available. Song lyrics and announcements will be projected. It is recommended that you bring your own Bible to worship. If you don't have one the Pastor would be delighted to help you select a new Bible!
- At the end of the service please exit promptly, please do not congregate in the building. We will exit by rear rows first.

Staffing and resources

- Welcome Host/Ushers – to help people follow the guidelines
- Hand Sanitizer placed at entrance and exit.
- Hymnals and Bibles to be put in storage.
- Need a supply of masks
