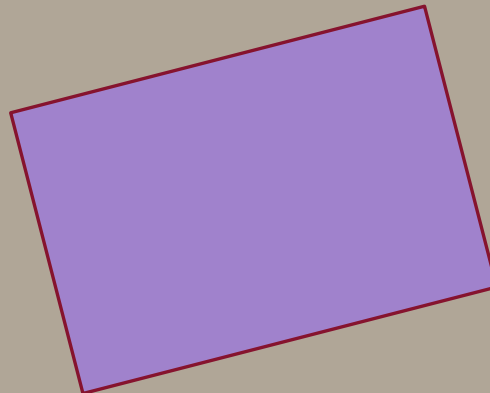

# Pastoral Prayer

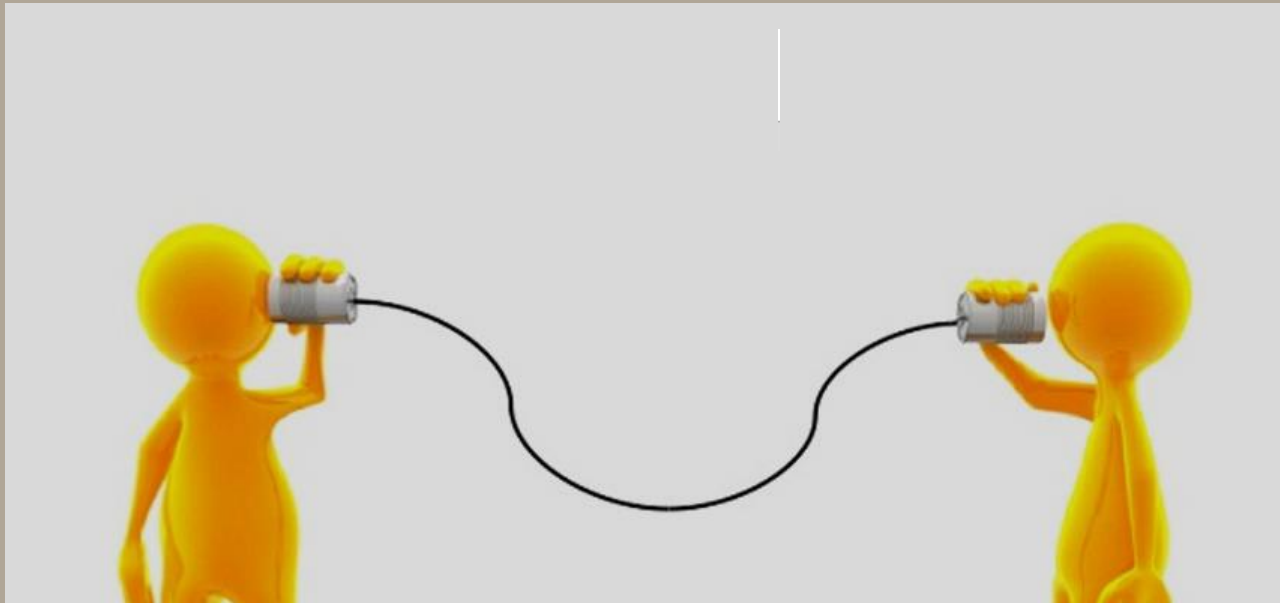


**Our Father,


