

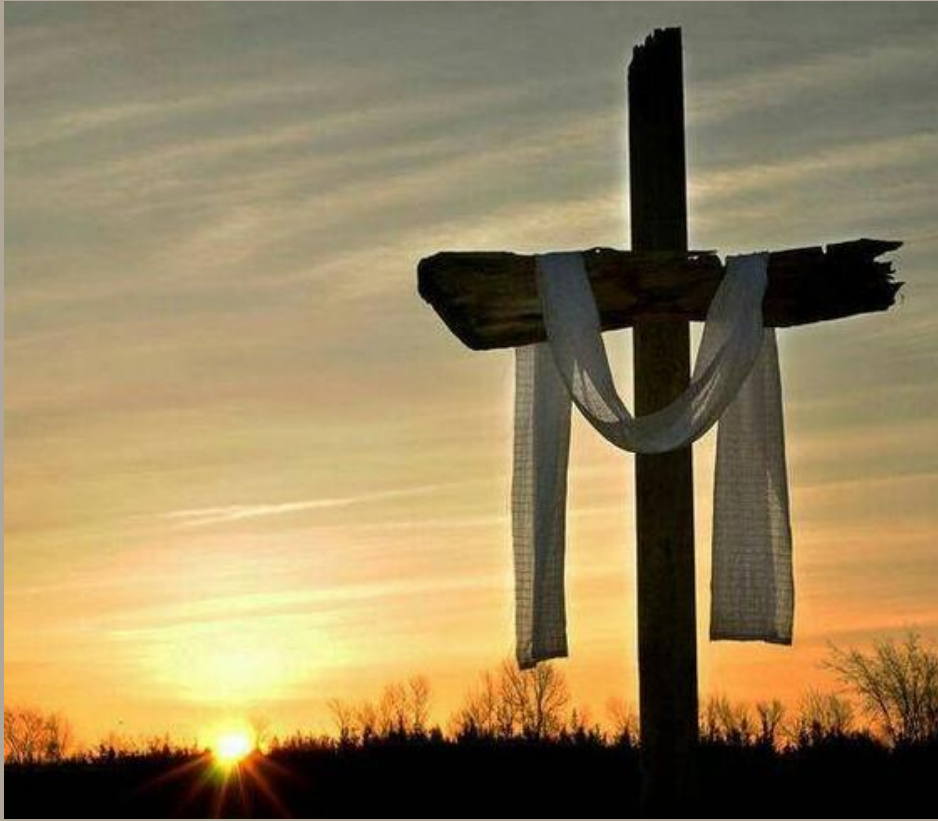

  - **Someone who can't work and has no safety net!**

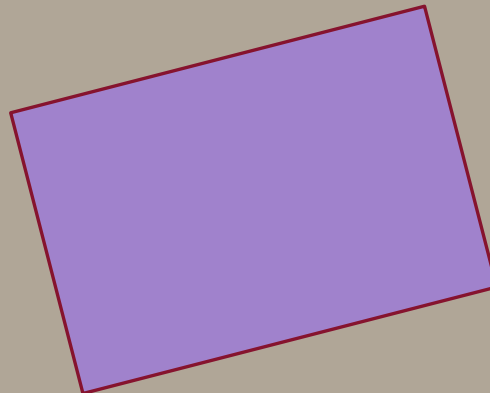

# Pastoral Prayer

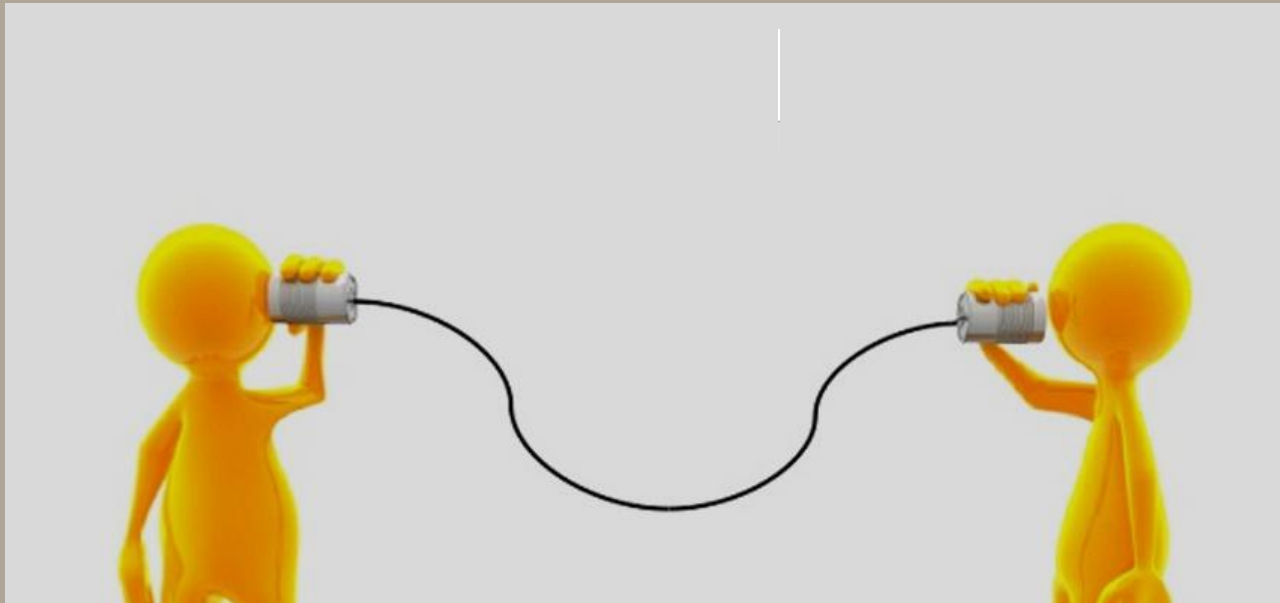


**Our Father,
