



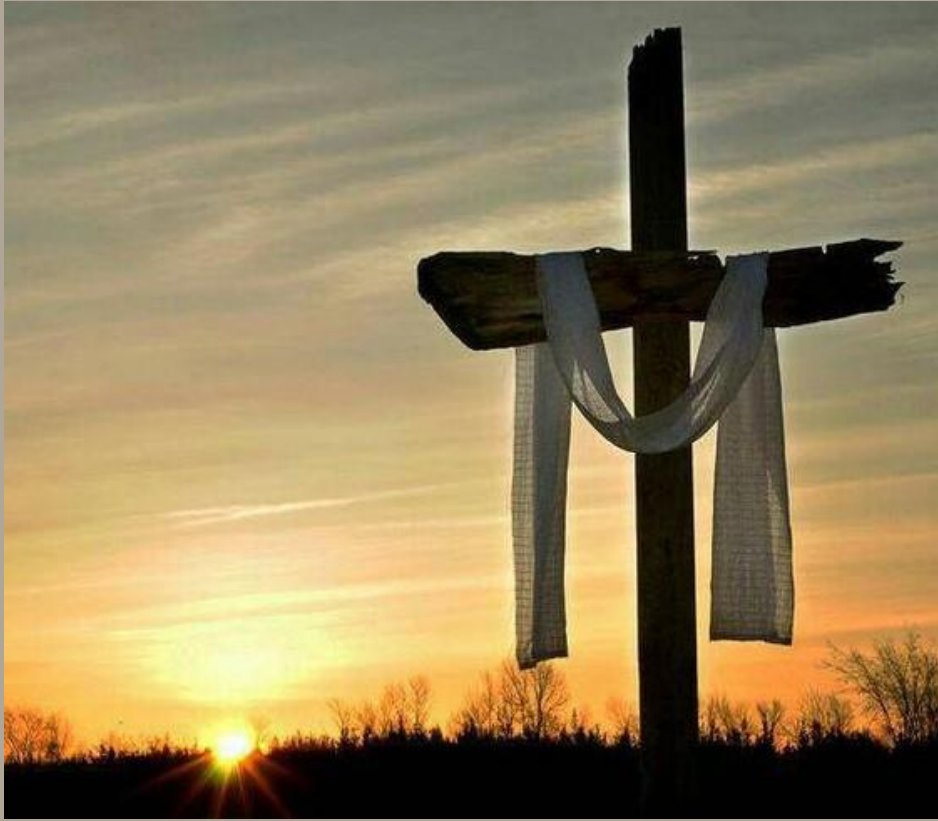

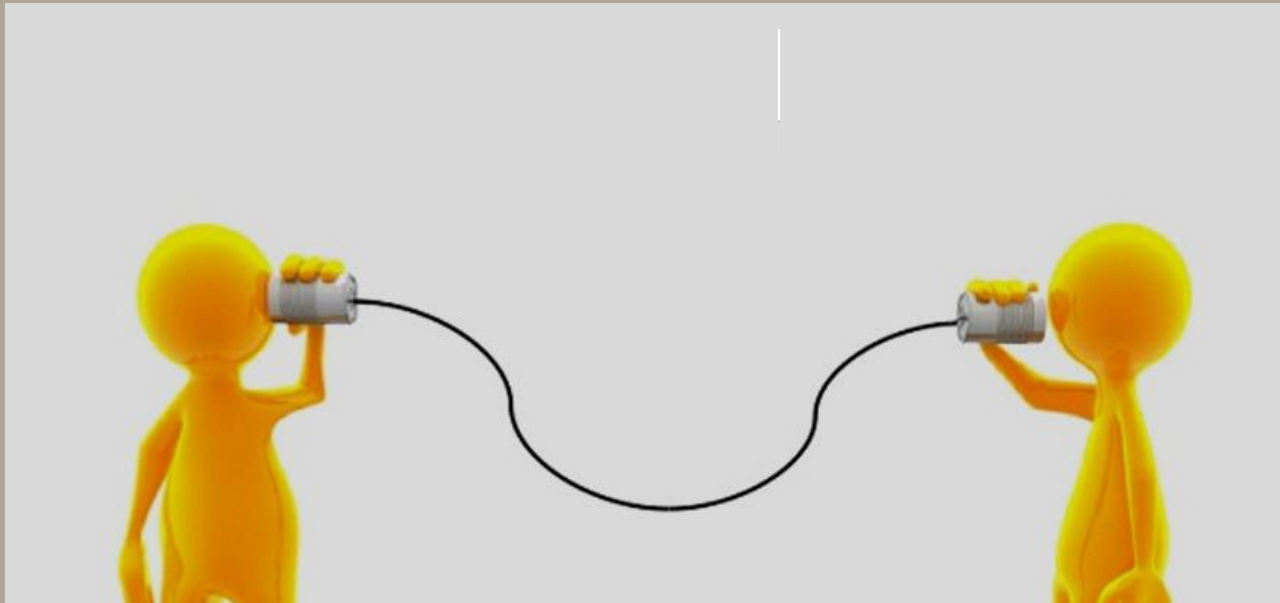
# Pastoral Prayer

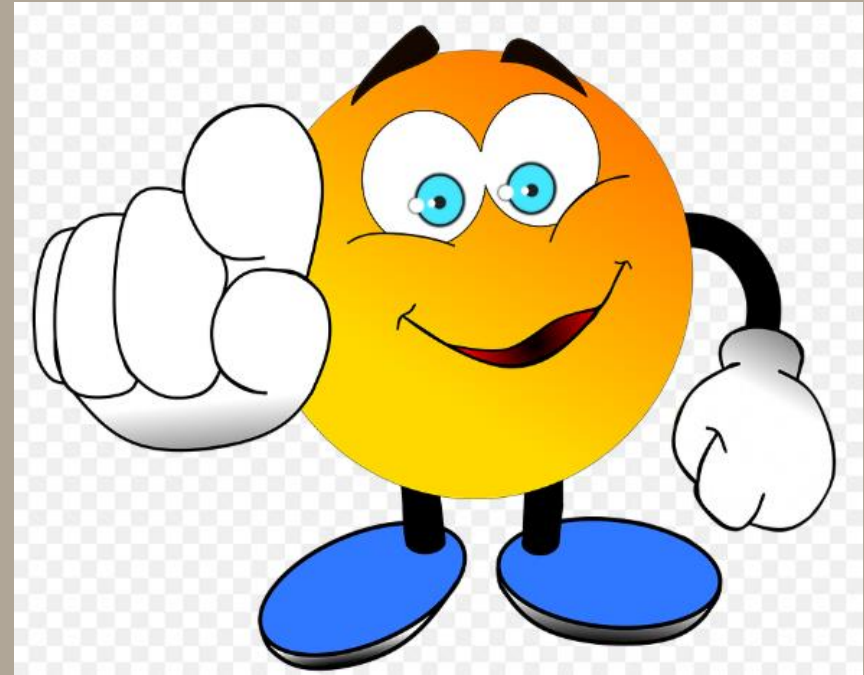
