


Prayer Time!

 - Those filled with Hatred-Evil










Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

We will be true to thee till death.


2. Faith of our fathers, we will strive to win all nations unto thee;
