- ⁵All day long they seek to injure my cause; all their thoughts are against me for evil. ⁶They stir up strife, they lurk, they watch my steps. As they hoped to have my life, ⁷so repay them for their crime; in wrath cast down the peoples, O God! ⁸You have kept count of my tossings; put my tears in your bottle. Are they not in your record? ⁹Then my enemies will retreat in the day
- when I call. This I know, that God is for me.

¹⁰In God, whose word I praise, in the Lord, whose word | praise, ¹¹in God I trust; I am not afraid. What can a mere mortal do to me? ¹²My vows to you I must perform, O God; I will render thank offerings to you. ¹³For you have delivered my soul from death, and my feet from falling, so that I may walk before God in the light of life.
