<u>Drive-In Christmas Eve service!</u> Christmas Eve, Dec 24 at 5:00! We are going to cancel our Bonfire/Candle Light service because of COVID-19 concerns. Instead, we are going to do a "Drive-In" Christmas Eve service! It will be "chilly" so we will keep it short, but still have a candle-lighting time and singing some familiar Christmas songs! The service will be broadcast to cars in the parking lot to your car radio on 104.3 FM.
