How does Lent help you? Or me?
(Or - do you like standing alone?)
What's Lent have to do with helping anyway??

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 Lent is a time when we are reminded that we don't have to stand alone...

- That we can call upon someone much greater than us...
- For comfort... strength... and guidance...
 And that someone is eagerly waiting for us!

 I would like to share how the season of Lent helps me...

- o But first a story about my Dad...
- o Strong, healthy, "squared away"...
- o P cancer...
- Fighter
- o Never admitted...
- O Death was inevitable
- We could not mourn with him...
- He wasn't able to reach out to us for support...

Most of us are a little bit like my Dad...
I'm doing just fine, thank you...
I have my... health, friends, money, occupation, the list goes on...

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Ol'm doing just fine... no need to reach out...
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Ountil something catastrophic happens..

 Farmers probably experience this more than most...

• They are at the mercy of the weather...

- They can go from the most awesome harvest ever...
- o To, absolutely nothing...
- Nothing they can do will change the weather...

- we are not in full control of our lives...
- A tornado... storms... drought... artic blast...
- o Employer... our own health...
- o If our spouse or partner leaves us...

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- We can take all the steps a wise and prudent person can take...
- O And still find ourselves in a bad way...

 When any of us experience one of these catastrophic events...

- olt turns us upside down...
- We loose our framework our stability and security...
- Frequently, depression creeps in...

- We all need something to grab onto when life gets too strong!
- olneed something to grab onto
- That's where the season of Lent comes in...

 Preparation is something we do before a disaster or catastrophe...

- So that when disaster hits we know what to do...
- Because our ability to think will not be working right...
- ○<>
- Think of Lent as a time of preparation of reflection
- olt's a time when we are reminded to admit
 - to ourselves...
- That we are not in full control of our lives...

- The season of Lent is a time that we are reminded that we don't have to stand alone...
- That we can call upon someone much greater than us...
- o For comfort... strength... and guidance...
- O And that someone is eagerly waiting for us!

 The Bible in Psalm 121 tells us how someone else experienced a time of catastrophe:

oI lift up my eyes to the hills— from where will my help come?

 My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth.

 He will not let your foot be moved; he who keeps you will not slumber. He who keeps Israel will neither slumber nor sleep.

- The Lord is your keeper; the Lord is your shade at your right hand.
- The sun shall not strike you by day, nor the moon by night.
- The Lord will keep you from all evil; he will keep your life.
- The Lord will keep your going out and your coming in from this time on and forevermore.

Matthew records these words from Jesus in 7:7-8:

 "Ask, and it will be given you; search, and you will find; knock, and the door will be opened for you. For everyone who asks receives, and everyone who searches finds, and for everyone who knocks, the door will be opened. But these words in Philippians give me personally the most comfort, Ch 4:4-9:

 Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice. Let your gentleness be known to everyone. The Lord is near. Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God.

 > the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. • Finally, beloved, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is pleasing, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence and if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. • Keep on doing the things that you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, and the God of peace will be with you.

 These words were written by the Apostle
 Paul to describe his experience with God in times of need and struggle...

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 In my own life I have also found comfort and strength from the presence of God in my heart...

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 For me, the most important gift from God is having peace in my heart - even in times of turmoil and upsets... The peace I get from reaching out to someone greater than myself...

 The peace I get being in relationship with Jesus and trusting Him!

- o That's why Lent is important to me...
- That's why I want to share the importance of Lent with others...
- It's not a magic pill... or silver bullet...
 It's a new way of living!
 Amen!

And lead us not into temptation, But deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, The power, and the glory, For ever and ever. Amen.

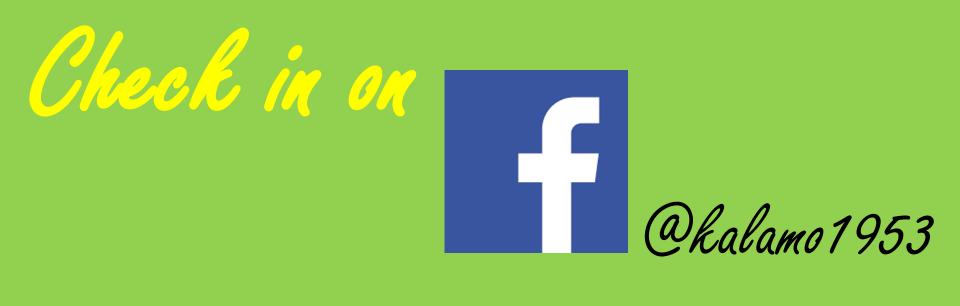
